



In 2018, the City of Camden will begin construction of improvements to several streets in Downtown and North Camden: Cooper Street, North 7th Street and Cooper's Poynt Roads. The projects will increase pedestrian and vehicular safety, reduce congestion and beautify the streetscapes. The following is a description of each project, location and construction schedule:

Cooper Street Pedestrian Access Project

Location: Cooper Street between Delaware Avenue and Haddon Avenue

Description: construction of a fenced median on each block between 5th Street and Haddon Avenue, traffic signal and pedestrian signal upgrades, ADA compliant curb ramps and crosswalks, removal of 6th Street median and installation of new traffic signal and new street trees.

Construction schedule: begin Fall 2018, completion Spring 2019

Cooper's Poynt Road Reconstruction Project

Location: street grid north of the Ben Franklin Bridge including Elm Street, Vine Street, Main Street, Point Street, Front Street, N. 2nd Street, N. 3rd Street and N. 4th Street

Description: replacement of underground utilities, construction of three mini-roundabouts along Main Street, new sidewalks, ADA compliant curb ramps and crosswalks, road resurfacing, landscaping, street trees and decorative lighting.

Construction schedule: begin Fall 2018, completion Spring 2020

7th Street Gateway Streetscape Improvement Project

Location: N. 7th Street between Linden Street and Elm Street

Description: stormwater system upgrades, median replacement, pedestrian safety measures, traffic and pedestrian signal upgrades, ADA compliant curb ramps and crosswalks, road resurfacing and landscaping.

Construction: begin Fall 2018, completion Fall 2019
