



NEW Pulse Homepage – Searching for Cooper Team Members

To search for Cooper team members, use the **Search People** box or **Address Book** in Outlook. This feature provides you with a team member's phone number, email, availability, location, and reporting structure, and also allows you to schedule a meeting with them right from that window
