Save the Date! Cooper University Health Care and Cooper Medical School of Rowan University (CMSRU) present the 11th Annual Camden Scholars' Forum Poster Contest.

This program recognizes outstanding achievement in Research and Quality Improvement. All eligible abstracts and posters will be judged by faculty and scored for the quality of content, design, title clarity and completeness, methods, results, and discussion/conclusions. Contest winners will give a short oral presentation about their project at the Winners' Forum.

The contest includes a set of posters and abstracts submitted and judged electronically. Winners will present their projects in person in the CMSRU auditorium. Carefully read the instructions that will help guide you to a successful poster submission.

Categories for Projects:

- Clinical
- Basic Science
- Case Study
- Quality Improvement (QI)
- Nursing Practice

The application website will go live Friday March 8th, 2024.

Performance Improvement projects include Quality Improvement, Quality Assurance, and Patient Safety projects. These projects focus on improving local systems of care - not generalized results.

- **IRB approval/QI letter** deadline (if required) is **Thursday, February 15, 2024**.
- **Final Biostatistics** data (if required) must be submitted by **Friday, March 1, 2024**.
- Contestants can submit applications and projects online starting **Friday, March 8, 2024**.
- Applications and projects will not be accepted after **11:59 PM on Friday, March 22, 2024**.
- Judging will begin **Wednesday, April 2, 2024**.
- Winners' Forum – Location: CMSRU Auditorium, Date: **May 2, 2024 @ 7AM-8AM. Immediately following the event refreshments will be served.**

CMSRU students who conducted projects this past year that have already been reviewed and approved by the IRB, do not need another IRB approval. Complete the application and submit abstract and poster.
