To be eligible for consideration, you must...

- Apply to requisition #19796 by Friday, July 26, 2024.
- Be in your current role or employed at Cooper for a minimum of 1 year.
- Be eligible to transfer on completion of this internship program.
- Be under no active discipline.
- Have a high school diploma or GED. You must provide proof to HR Recruitment within 24 hours of applying.
- Provide two letters of recommendation at the time you apply online; one letter of recommendation must be from your current Cooper manager.
- Be able to successfully fulfill your current work schedule and complete the required 187 didactic hours and additional clinical hours of our internship program.
