We are offering optional **ONLINE FACILITATOR TRAINING** (30 minutes) that will be recorded if you cannot attend the training.

### KEY FACILITATORS' RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Facilitate a small group session of inter-professional students (choice of 1-4 sessions)
- Familiarize yourself with the 'Facilitator guide' provided
- Facilitators are highly encouraged to review the patient case prior to the experience.
- Facilitators will share the patient case slide set on the screen.
- Facilitators will gradually unfold the case, slide by slide corresponding to the timeline of the case for team discussion and time to develop a care plan and complete post survey
- During this portion of the session, facilitators should:
  - Aim to step back at first from the discussion to allow students an opportunity to lead.
  - The purpose of this activity is for the students to speak and if the students are stuck ask global open-ended questions.
- Facilitators are encouraged to use the guide (provided) to discuss key points corresponding to each profession's roles and responsibilities.
- Make sure the interprofessional team has 5 to 10 minutes at the end to develop a care plan to discuss with the patient.
- Facilitators will lead a debrief of the experience. Some suggestions for debrief:
  - What was an "ah-ha" moment from today?
  - What will be your major takeaway from today and how will you apply it to your career?
  - If you could repeat this experience again what would you do differently?
  - What professions do you wish could have been present for this experience?
- Facilitators will display the last slide with survey QR code for students.
