


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### Adding Nurse Transport Report to the Summary Tab




- In the summary tab select the **expand down arrow next to the wrench icon**
- **Add or remove tabs** from toolbar




→ Opens the Add/Remove Tab pop up

- In the empty box at the bottom of the list **search for and select Nurse Transport Report** to add to the list.
  - The list order can be modified using the up/down arrows on the side after an item has been added
- **Accept**
