# **EMT Training Program**

  - Sundays from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
- ► Total sessions: 38 classroom and training sessions
- Cost: Fully sponsored for selected participants.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Must be in your current role and employed at Cooper for at least one year.
- High school diploma or GED (Must upload proof to your Cooper Profile as part of your application requirement.)
- ▶ No active discipline.
- Must be eligible to transfer roles upon program completion.
- Submit two letters of recommendation (one must be from your current manager) to fugee-antoinette@cooperhealth.edu.
- Must maintain current work schedule while attending all training sessions.
- Must agree to register for the NREMT Certification Exam upon completion.
- Selected candidates must sign an EMT Training Program Agreement which includes a one-year commitment agreement to Cooper upon successful completion of the program.
